Dear Central Westmoreland CTC Families, Faculty and Staff,

The Central Westmoreland Career and Technology Center was alerted that there has been a possible exposure to COVID-19 through a student who attends the **Central Westmoreland Career and Technology Center**. At this time, it has been confirmed that a student has tested positive for COVID-19. District administration has been in direct contact with the Pennsylvania Department of Health (PADoH) and is receiving guidance through the PA Rapid Response Center (RRC). At this time their guidance does not recommend school closure. In response to the known situation, the CTC has already implemented a deep cleaning protocol of all identified rooms/areas.

We will keep you updated should more information become available. In the interim, please monitor for symptoms and remember to notify the CTC administration and/or school nurse should your child test positive and/or be exposed to COVID-19 through family or friends. Additionally, please do not ask members of our team for more details or names as we are not permitted to share that information due to student privacy.
