Classes will be held February 20, 26 & 27, 2024 from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. COST: \$ 164.99 Cost includes \$125.00 to CWCTC for class and \$39.99 to PennDOT/PARSONS for online test.

STATE SAFETY INSPECTOR CERTIFICATION

A twenty-hour course that covers all of the rules, regulations, tools and procedures for the safety inspection of cars and light trucks. State required equipment and regulations are discussed along with demonstrations. Class fee includes instruction, reference manual, tool seminar, written exam tactile exam. Inspection of motorcycles is available at an additional charge and requires additional class time. Student must possess a valid driver's license and be at least 18 years old. Please call for Inspection Registration.
